NOTES FOR BURMA VISAS

British passport holders require a visa for Burma. If you are not a British passport holder, please check with your nearest Burmese Embassy. You must obtain your Burmese visa **before** departure. This can either be done:

- Through Travcour, who will apply for the visa on your behalf but there will be a service charge. They are a very experienced visa agency that Exodus has worked with for many years.
- Or directly with the Burmese Embassy.

OPTION 1. VIA TRAVCOUR, OUR RECOMMENDED VISA AGENCY

OPTION 2. E-VISA

Normal Process	<p>Step 1: Enter the website http://evisa.moip.gov.mm/NewApplication.aspx</p> <p>Step 2: fill in required information, upload a non-smiling picture with white or off white background (4.6cm x 3.8cm, max 2MB)</p> <p>Step 3: Wait for the approval letter that will be emailed to you within 3 working days and print it.</p>

OPTION 3. APPLY FOR VISA THROUGH THE EMBASSY

Normal Process	<p>Step 1: Download and fill in the visa application form from their website http://www.londonmyanmarembassy.com/</p> <p>You can either apply in person, or by post.</p> <p>Step 2: Submit 1 filled in application forms, 2 passport photos (white or off white background), a passport which is valid for at least 6 months beyond the intended length of stay, flight itinerary plus the visa fee (payable by cash or postal order only).</p> <p>Include a self addressed envelope if you want your passport returned by post.</p> <p>Applications must be submitted to Embassy of Myanmar at:</p>
